IMPORTANT INFORMATION! **We will have one in-person registration, Wednesday, October 16th, 2019, at 6:30pm at Frelinghuysen Middle School in the auditorium. You may only register your child/ren at this time. Additional registration forms will not be accepted.**

1. Students must ride the bus to and from Shawnee. The only allowance is for a parent to sign out **ONLY** their own child/ren with the chaperone at the ski program departure time. **THIS IS THE ONLY EXCEPTION.**

Helmets are required! Shawnee will be offering helmets at a substantial discount. Information regarding the helmets will be handed out at the parent information meeting.

To enroll your child, please bring payment to the FMS Auditorium of \$299.00 along with the attached forms (completed) on Wednesday, October 16th at 6:30pm. When the completed forms are processed by the Community School office, the website link for Shawnee Mountain will be emailed to you. At the website, you will be able to register for the package of your choice. The Shawnee Mountain payment by credit card must be completed by Friday, November 8, 2019, in order for your child to participate in the Frelinghuysen Middle School Ski Program. Once your child is registered with the Community School, no refunds will be given unless we have a wait list and someone will take your place.
